He earned a Master's degree in Social Sciences from San Jose State University. He then worked as a laborer, counselor, dancer, and poet. When he had kids, he decided to try writing for kids. The character started out as stories he told to his two sons. London's *Froggy* series has sold over 16 million copies in North America and has been translated into eight different languages. The series has also won numerous awards.

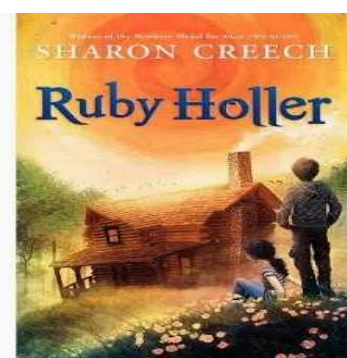
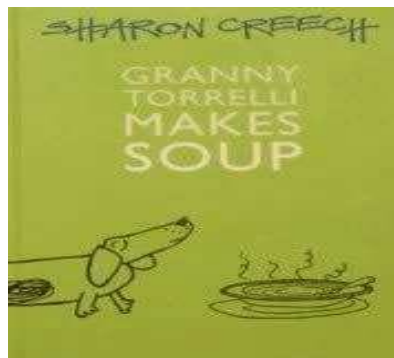
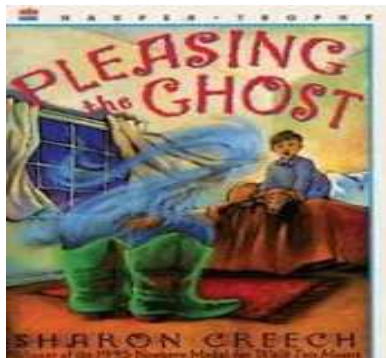
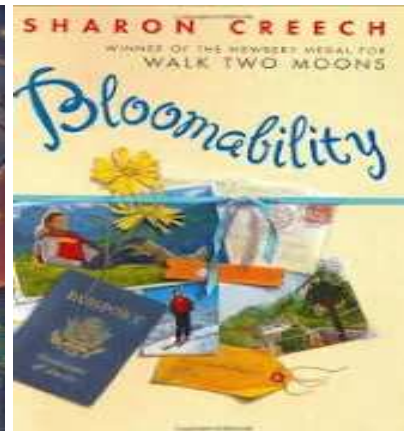
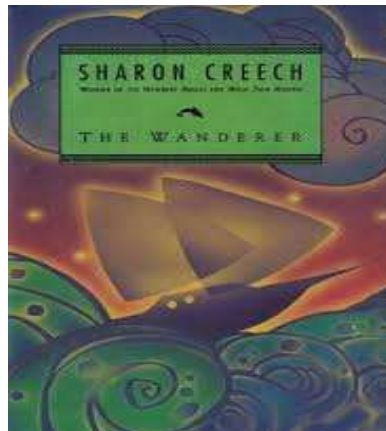
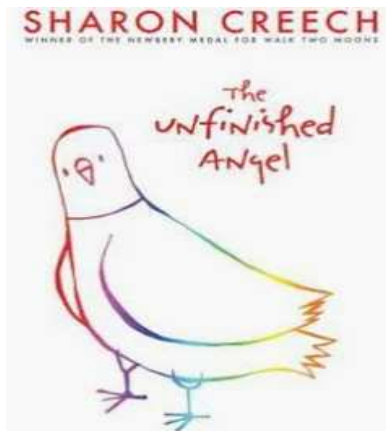
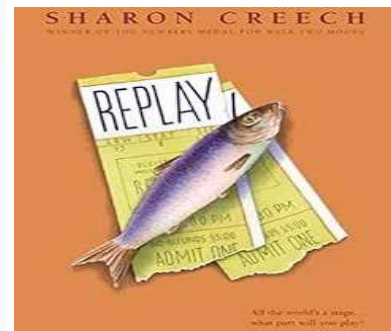
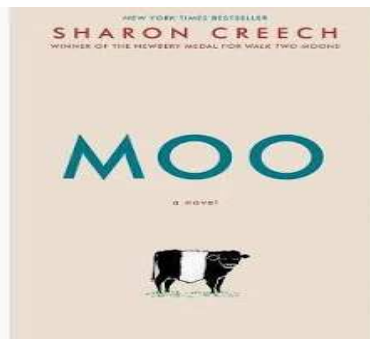
Sharon Creech
